

Mathematics:

We will begin the term by consolidating our times table knowledge for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. For this the children will practise applying the multiplication and division facts. We shall also be looking at Measurement and Fractions. The children will practise telling the time accurately and focus on fractions of shapes and fractions of numbers.

P.E:

During the Spring Term the Year 3 classes will take part in Dance, Gymnastics and Games. Our P.E. Coach will be taking the Year 3 children for apparatus lessons for half of the term.

R.E. and P.S.H.E

Our topics shall be 'Islam,' 'The Easter Story,' 'Relationships and 'Going for Goals.'



Topic – The Victorians

During the Spring Term the Year 3 children will be exploring Victorian Britain. The children will learn about who the Victorians were; Queen Victorian; Victorian toys; School life; Victorian life and jobs; Victorian inventors and life in a Workhouse. Our school trip will be a visit to Southwell Workhouse.



English:

The first half term our reading and writing will be focussed around 'Oliver', a child friendly version of the Charles Dickens classic. After half term we will explore 'Street Child', another novel set in Victorian Britain.

Science:

We will be exploring 'Forces and Magnets' during our science week at the end of the first half term. Our topic after half term will be 'Animals including Humans', where our focus will be on animal and human skeletons.

Computing:

We will be focussing on programming skills and Word Processing.
